Agreement, Waiver & Release – ORANGEVALE GRANGE #354 - 2021

In consideration for being permitted by the Orangevale Grange #354 to participate in the Community Garden, I hereby waive, release, and discharge any and all claims for damages, for personal injury, death, or damage which I may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me, as a result of participation in the said property. This release is intended to discharge in advance the Orangevale Grange #354, State Grange or National Grange (its officers, employees, and agents) and the Community Garden Coordinating Committee from any and all liability arising out of, or connected in any way with, my participation in the Community Garden, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities mentioned above. It is understood that this activity involves an element of risk and danger of accidents, and knowing those risks, I hereby assume those risks. It is further agreed that this waiver, release and assumption of risks is to be binding by my heirs and assigns. **I agree to indemnify and to hold the above persons or entities free and harmless from any loss, liability, damage, or expense, which they may incur as a result in my death or injury damage that I may sustain while participating in the Community Garden.**

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THE COMMUNITY GARDEN GUIDELINES WAIVER AND RELEASE, AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. I AM AWARE THAT THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND A CONTRACT TO COMPLY WITH THE COMMUNITY ORANGEVALE GRANGE #354 COMMUNITY GARDEN PROJECT GUIDELINES BETWEEN THE ORANGEVALE GRANGE #354, AND MYSELF, AND I SIGN OF MY OWN FREE WILL.

I understand and agree that these guidelines and agreement create nothing more than a revocable license to use for a limited time, the plot (garden box) that is assigned to me, that the license is limited by these guidelines and policies and further limited by the terms of the license granted by the Orangevale Grange #354, and that the license is terminable without cause at the will of the Orangevale Grange Community Garden Project and the Orangevale Grange #354.
